- Coats Dual Duty XP® All-purpose thread in colors to match fabrics
- 79" x 91" (200.66cm x 231.14cm) batting
- Sewing machine
- Rotary cutter/mat/ruler
- Basic sewing and pressing supplies

Cutting

WOF=width of fabric; LOF=length of fabric

Fabric A, cut:

(1) $24\frac{1}{2}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " (62.23cm x 92.71cm) from the upper left hand corner of the fabric length for quilt center (the $24\frac{1}{2}$ " (62.23cm) dimension is WOF and the $36\frac{1}{2}$ " (92.71cm dimension is LOF); from the remaining fabric, cut (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x LOF (6.35cm x LOF), for binding

Fabric B, cut:

(4) 7" x WOF (17.78cm x WOF); sub-cut (2) 7" x 36½" (17.78cm x 92.71cm) and (2) 7" x 37½" (17.78cm x 95.25cm), for Border 1 (7) 7" x WOF (17.78cm x WOF), for Border 4

Fabric C, cut:

(5) 4" x WOF (10.16cm x WOF), for Border 2

Fabric D, cut:

(6) 4" x WOF (10.16cm x WOF), for Border 3

Fabric E, cut:

(8) 4" x WOF (10.16cm x WOF), for Border 5

Sewing

Notes:

- Use a ¼" (.64cm) seam allowance throughout. Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges using matching thread.
- When piecing border strips, sew end to end, matching adjacent stripes for a continuous look.

Border 2

1. Remove the selvages and sew the (5) 4" x WOF (10.16cm x WOF) **Fabric C** strips together along the 4" (10.16cm) edges to form one continuous strip. Press the seam allowances open. Cut (2) 4" x 49½" (10.16cm x 125.73cm) and (2) 4" x 44½" (10.16cm x 113.03cm) for Border 2.

Border 3

Repeat Step 1 to sew the (6) 4" x WOF (10.16cm x WOF) Fabric D strips together. Cut (2) 4" x 56½" (10.16cm x 143.51cm) and (2) 4" x 51½" (10.16cm x 130.81cm) for Border 3.

Border 4

Repeat Step 1 to sew the (7) 7" x WOF (17.78cm x WOF) Fabric B strips together along the 7" (17.78cm) edges. Cut (2) 7" x 63½" (17.78cm x 161.29cm) and (2) 7" x 64½" (17.78cm x 163.83cm) for Border 4.

Border 5

Repeat Step 1 to sew the (8) 4" x WOF (10.16cm x WOF1) Fabric E strips together. Cut (2) 4" x 76½" (10.16cm x 194.31cm) and (2) 4" x 71½" (10.16cm x 181.61cm) for Border 5.

Quilt Assembly

Note: Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the guilt.

- 5. Sew (1) 7" x 36½" (17.78cm x 92.71cm)

 Fabric B Border 1 strip to each side of the 24½" x 36½" (62.23cm x 92.71cm) Fabric A quilt center.

 Press the seams allowances toward the borders.
- **6.** Sew (1) 7" x 37½" (17.78cm x 95.3cm) **Fabric B**Border 1 strip to the top and the other to the bottom of the guilt center.
- 7. Repeat Steps 5 and 6 to sew the (2) 4" x 49½" (10.16cm x 125.73cm) Fabric C Border 2 strips to the sides of the quilt center and then the (2) 4" x 44½" (10.16cm x 113.03cm) Fabric C Border 2 strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
- 8. Continuing this sequence, sew the (2) 4" x 56½" (10.16cm x 143.51cm) Fabric D strips to the quilt center sides and then the (2) 4" x 51½" (10.16cm x 130.81cm) Fabric D strips to the top and bottom to complete Border 3. Then sew the (2) 7" x 63½" (17.78cm x 161.29cm) Fabric B strips to the sides and (2) 7" x 64½" (17.78cm x 163.83cm) Fabric B strips to the top and bottom to complete Border 4. Finally, sew the (2) 4" x 76½" (10.16cm x 194.31cm) Fabric E strips to the sides and the (2) 4" x 71½" (10.16cm x 181.61cm) Fabric E strips to the top and bottom to complete Border 5.




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Finishing

- **9.** Layer the backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the quilt top.
- **10.** Sew the (8) 2½" x WOF (6.35cm x LOF) **Fabric A** strips together end to end using diagonal seams to make one continuous binding strip. Press seams open. Press the strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together.
- 11. Leaving an 8" (20.32cm) tail of binding, sew the binding to the top of the quilt through all layers with raw edges matching. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" (30.48cm) from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along the quilt edge. Where the loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" (.64cm) and press open. Finish sewing binding to the quilt.
- 12. Turn binding to back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
