Finished Quilt Size: $47^{\prime \prime} \times 47^{\prime \prime}(68.58 \mathrm{~cm} \times 68.58 \mathrm{~cm})$
Materials:
$11 / 2$ yds. (1.37m) Rowan Classics by Kaffe Fassett, Paperweight in purple,GP20.PURPLE (alternative choice Rowan Classics by Kaffe Fassett, Paperweight in jewel, GP20.JEWEL)
Rowan Kaffe Fassett Collection 6" Design Roll, Leafy (FB6DSGP.LEAFY)
Binding: Leftover Rowan Classics by Kaffe Fassett, Paperweight
Backing: 3 yds (2.74m)
Accessories: Rowan Kaffe Fassett Design Wall (DWBAGGP.RUSTX or DWBAGGP.TANGE)

Cutting:
Cut border from the Rowan Classics by Kaffe Fassett, Paperweight.
2 strips $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 471 /{ }^{\prime \prime}(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 1.2 \mathrm{~m})$
2 strips $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41$ ½" ( $8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 1.05 \mathrm{~m}$ )
From the Rowan Kaffe Fassett Collection 6" Design Roll, Leafy
Sort the fabric into two groups; light and dark.
Group 1: Blues including Rowan Classics by Kaffe Fassett Paperweight GP20 Jewel (dark green)
Group 2: Greens including Rowan Classics by Kaffe Fassett GP70 Grape Spots
Balance of fabrics from the Rowan Kaffe Fassett Collection 6" Design Roll, Leafy
Cut in strips $6 \prime$ ( 5.24 cm ) long and in varying widths.
8 pcs. $=1^{\prime \prime}$ wide $(2.54 \mathrm{~cm})$
8 pcs. $-1 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ wide ( 3.81 cm )
8 pcs. $-2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm})$
8 pcs. $-2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide ( 6.35 cm )
It may be necessary to cut more strips as you need them.
From your $6^{\prime \prime}$ long strips keep lights and dark separate. Put each size in a pile and mark the piles in the following way.
The fabric measuring $1^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}, \times 15.24 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) mark as .5
The fabric measuring $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime},(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 15.24 \mathrm{~cm})$ mark as 1
The fabric measuring $2^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime},(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 15.24 \mathrm{~cm})$ mark as 1.5
The fabric measuring $2 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime},(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 15.24 \mathrm{~cm})$ mark as 2

Sewing Directions:
Note: All seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ ( 6.35 mm ).

Sew the lights only with lights and darks only with darks. Sew strips of various widths and fabrics together in sets. The goal is to add up the numbers you marked to equal 5.5. For example: $.5+1.5+2+1.5=5.5 \quad$ OR $1+1.5+1+2$ Any variation of strips works as long as the numbers add up to 5.5 . This will yield blocks that will measure $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}(15.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 15.24 \mathrm{~cm})$.

Make 32 light and 32 dark blocks
Press each block very well. Square up to $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}(15.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 15.24 \mathrm{~cm})$ if necessary. Cut each block diagonally from the upper left corner to the lower right corner making two half square triangles from each. Do this for all the blocks.

Take one light triangle and sew it to one dark triangle along the hypotenuse (longest side of the triangle)

Make 64 blocks

Assembling the top:

Using the Rowan Kaffe Fassett Design Wall, place the blocks into 8 across and 8 rows down. Turn them so that it makes any of the three suggested layouts or do one of your own.

Sew the rows together.
Sew the shorter border lengths to the sides.
Sew the longer border lengths to the top and bottom.

Finishing:

Layer with batting and backing.
Baste.
Quilt as desired.
Trim. Bind with left over Rowan Classics by Kaffe Fassett, Paperweight.
