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## Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric

Label pieces with the border numbers as they are cut.

## Fabric A, cut:

(1) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut
(1) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times 12^{1 / 2 "}(13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 31.75 \mathrm{~cm})$ Center Panel and
(2) $2^{1 / 2 " \prime} \times 27^{1 / 2 "}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 69.85 \mathrm{~cm})$ for binding
(7) $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF $)$ for binding

Fabric B, cut:
(2) $4^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut
(2) $4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{1} / 22^{\prime \prime}(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 52.07 \mathrm{~cm})$ Border 1 side strips and
(2) $4^{1 / 2 "} \times 6^{1 / 2 "}(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$ Border 1 top/bottom strips

Fabric C, cut:
(3) $4^{1 / 2 " 1} \times$ WOF ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut
(2) $4^{1 / 2 "} \times 28^{1} / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 72.39 \mathrm{~cm})$ Border 2 side strips and
(2) $4^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 36.83 \mathrm{~cm})$ Border 2 top/bottom strips

Fabric D, cut:
(3) $4^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) for Border 3

Fabric E, cut:
(4) $4^{11 / 2 " ~} \times$ WOF ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) for Border 4

## Fabric F, cut:

(5) $4^{1 / 12 "} \times$ WOF ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) for Border 5

Fabric G, cut:
(6) $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) for Border 6

## Fabric H, cut:

(7) $4^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) for Border 7

## Fabric I, cut:

(7) $4^{1 / 2} \times$ WOF ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) for Border 8

## Fabric J, cut:

(8) $4^{1 / 2} \times$ WOF ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) for Border 9

## Instructions

All seam allowances are $1 / 411(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ and pieces are sewn right sides together.

## Quilt Top Assembly

Note: Follow the Quilt Layout diagram while assembling the quilt.

1. Sew together the (3) $4^{1 / 2 "}(11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric $D$ Border 3 strips end to end using a straight seam. Press the seam allowances open. Cut (2) $4^{1 / 2 " 1} \times 36^{1 / 2 " 1}(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 92.71 \mathrm{~cm})$ Border 3 side strips and (2) $4^{1 / 2 " ~} \times$ $22^{1 / 2 "}$ " $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm})$ Border 3 top/bottom strips.
2. Repeat Step 1 to sew together and cut the remaining border strips listed in the table below.

| Border 5 - Fabric F | $\begin{gathered} 4^{11 / 2 "} \times 52^{1} 22^{\prime \prime} \\ (11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \end{gathered}$ | $\begin{gathered} 4^{1 / 21} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 38^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \\ (11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 97.79 \mathrm{~cm}) \end{gathered}$ |
| Border 6 - Fabric G | $\begin{gathered} 4^{11 / 2 "} \times 60^{1} / 22^{\prime \prime} \\ (11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 153.67 \mathrm{~cm}) \end{gathered}$ | $\begin{gathered} 4^{1 / 21} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 46^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \\ (11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 118.11 \mathrm{~cm}) \end{gathered}$ |
| Border 7 - Fabric H | $\begin{gathered} 4^{1} / 2 " 1 \times 68^{1} / 2 " 1 \\ (11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 173.99 \mathrm{~cm}) \\ \hline \end{gathered}$ | $\begin{gathered} 4^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 54^{1} / 2 " \\ (11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 138.43 \mathrm{~cm}) \\ \hline \end{gathered}$ |
| Border 8 - Fabric I | $\begin{gathered} 4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 76^{1} / 22^{\prime \prime} \\ (11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 194.31 \mathrm{~cm}) \end{gathered}$ | $\begin{gathered} 4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 62^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \\ (11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 158.75 \mathrm{~cm}) \end{gathered}$ |
| Border 9 - Fabric J | $\begin{gathered} 4^{11 / 2 " ~} \times 84^{1 / 2 " 2} \\ (11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 214.63 \mathrm{~cm}) \end{gathered}$ | $\begin{gathered} 4^{1 / 21 "} \times 70^{1 / 2 " 1} \\ (11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 179.07 \mathrm{~cm}) \end{gathered}$ |

3. Sew the Border 1 top/bottom strips to the top and bottom edges of the Fabric A Center Panel. Press the seam allowances toward the borders. Sew the Border 1 side strips to the side edges of the Center Panel to complete Border 1. The Quilt Center measures $14^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ $(36.83 \mathrm{~cm} \times 52.07 \mathrm{~cm})$.
4. Repeat the process in Step 3 to add the Border 2 top/bottom strips, followed by the side strips to the quilt center.
5. Continue adding the Borders 3 through 9, in numerical order, to complete the quilt top.

## Finishing

6. Sew together the $2^{1} / 2$ " $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric $\mathbf{A}$ binding strips end to end using straight seams. Press seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
7. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
8. Leaving an 8 " $(20.32 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail of binding, sew the binding to the top of the quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12 " $(30.48 \mathrm{~cm})$ from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where the loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
9. Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.

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
